

Starlings Preschool no smoking Policy

Policy statement

We comply health and safety regulations and the Safeguarding and Welfare requirements of the early years foundation stage in making our setting a no-smoking environment – both indoors and outdoors.

Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our No-smoking policy
- We display no smoking signs
- The no-smoking policy is stated in our information for parents
- We actively encourage no-smoking by having information for parents and staff about where to get help to stop smoking if they are seeking this information
- Staff who do smoke do not do so during working hours, unless on a break and off the premises
- Staff who smoking during their break make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues
